School's OUT are currently advertising on seek for more people to join our team!

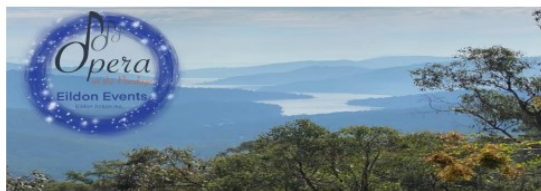
If you know anyone who would suit the position, please encourage them to apply.
