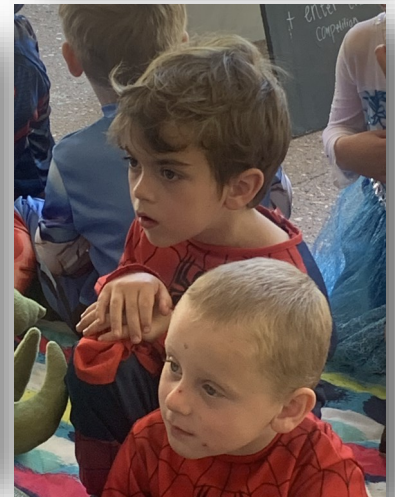
Kindergarten Report
